Amanda Calderon Announces Candidacy for United States Senate in Colorado

DENVER, CO - Amanda Calderon, a Colorado native, military wife, and principled conservative, officially filed her candidacy for the United States Senate with the Colorado Secretary of State. Calderon will seek the Republican nomination to challenge incumbent Senator John Hickenlooper in the 2026 general election.

"I'm running to stop the waste in Washington and restore trust in our institutions," Calderon said. "Colorado families deserve a senator who listens, who respects the Constitution, and who will fight every day for working people-not political elites."

Calderon's campaign will focus on fiscal responsibility, government accountability, public safety, and defending individual liberties. Her campaign begins with a grassroots effort to qualify for the ballot by petition, requiring signatures from all eight congressional districts by March 17, 2026.

With deep roots in Colorado and a background in business and civic leadership, Calderon believes it's time for a new voice in the U.S. Senate who will prioritize the people over the politics.
